Dear Kids Klub Families,

We hope you had a safe and relaxing weekend. As we find ourselves in the midst of a surge of COVID-19 cases, we continue to challenge ourselves to keep our Kids Klub community safe. We are in touch with the Pasadena and LA County Health departments and State Licensing on basically a daily basis, especially now. The County Health Officer put out an order to require that staff wear a “well-fitted medical grade mask, surgical mask or higher-level respirator,” such as an N95 or KN95 “at all times while indoors” effective Monday, January 17, 2022. We have proactively ordered 8,000 KN95 masks to be able to provide all of our staff (over 150) with a KN-95 mask every day—and we made this higher mask requirement effective today. Furthermore, we continue to require everyone 2 years old and up to wear a mask both indoors AND outdoors at all times, with the exception of actively eating, drinking or napping. We strongly encourage you to send your children to Kids Klub in either surgical masks, KN95s, N95s, KF94s or double masks.

Additionally, we have ordered 4-stage air purifiers [i.e. 1) Carbon Filter, 2) HEPA Filter, 3) Ion Generation, and 4) UV-C Light Sterilization] for every classroom. They should finally be arriving on Wednesday and placed in each classroom around the centers.

We continue our sanitization procedures throughout the centers as we have been doing and continue to closely monitor all staff and families and address every potential exposure on an individual basis in consultation with the Health Departments to determine if quarantines are required.

As we have said in the past, we will continue to do everything in our power to keep COVID-19 from spreading in our centers. We must rely on you and our staff to keep it from entering our centers. Again, please contact us and refrain from coming to the center if you or a member of your household is experiencing symptoms of any kind. Please report any potential close contacts and err on the side of caution as we have and will continue to do. We will get through the Omicron variant spike. Fortunately, with the nature of the variant and the proliferation of vaccinations and boosters, we are NOT also seeing a rise in serious hospitalizations or deaths from this variant.
