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Sick Child Policy Please remember that if your child has any signs of illness to keep your child home. We require that children be fever free without medication for at least 48 hours prior to returning to school.

Any child who may fall ill while in school, will be isolated in Ms. Mary's office until picked up by a parent or guardian . All isolated children are required to be picked up with in a 1 hour period. They may not return to school without a note from a physician stating that the child is either not contagious or is no longer contagious.
